We are data driven, hold students accountable and have high academic expectations. We are very honored to have been a 4 Star school for the last two years and an "A" school according to the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) every year since 2009. The IDOE also recognized us as one of their 200 Promising Practices schools for Data Driven Instruction. In addition, we have been recognized as an Indiana Bicentennial Legacy Project by the Indiana Bicentennial Committee. Besides our academic focus, we also focus on teaching our students how to serve others. Every grade level completes service projects to make a positive impact on our community.

Infinite Campus

Infinite Campus is the name of our student information/management system. Infinite Campus provides valuable information for parents including grades, attendance, assignments, messages from the teacher, and district wide messaging. There are also other tools which parents will find valuable. The parent access feature is designed specifically for parents. If there are multiple children in school, the information for all children is displayed on the parent portal.

And – "there's an app for that"! If you have an iPhone, you may download the free app from the app store to give you instant information at your fingertips. Communication is essential to the success of our students!

Technology at Bunker Hill:

Each classroom is set up with a document camera to project from the teacher iPad. In addition, we have 4 Chromebook carts, each complete with 35 Chromebooks and 2 Mobile Laptop carts with 30 Laptops for staff and students to check out, as well as two complete state of the art computer labs designed for teacher instruction.
